

Great Notley Parish Council Strategy Statement

The strategy and intentions of Great Notley Parish Council for the next 12 months is as follows –

1. To continue to maintain a clean and tidy environment within the Parish by employing a team of litter pickers to work in the Parish and providing a suitable number of litter bins.
2. To meet the administrative costs of the running of the Parish Council in the discharge of its statutory duties including the cost of employing the Clerk.
3. To maintain the storage unit
4. To continue to communicate with residents via the production of a quarterly magazine and by maintaining noticeboards, a website and a Facebook page.
5. To support community groups within the Parish by way of a small grants scheme
6. To maintain the small number of Parish owned streetlights.
7. To maintain the Levens Way play area.
8. To progress with the improvement and upgrade of the RAFT including consultation with the community and the provision of suitable equipment.
9. To maintain the White Court Memorial site and continue to support the Remembrance Day Service
10. To host and organise the annual Torchlight Procession and Carol Service
11. To support volunteer groups in relation to the maintenance of green spaces around the Parish.
12. To install White Gates at the 'Tesco' entrance to the Parish with the aim of reminding those entering the Parish that they are entering a residential area.
13. To continue to support the long standing principle of the provision of allotments within the Parish and to make contingency for that cost.
