Report on outcome of Survey for parking restrictions at Wood Way and Cuckoo Way, Great Notley

Following an application to the North Essex Parking Partnership (NEPP) to request parking restrictions on parts of Wood Way and Cuckoo Way, Great Notley Parish Council was advised by the NEPP that the measures that could feasibly be put in place were a single timed red route restriction on the opposite side of the road to numbers 2-40 Cuckoo Way, with double red route junction protection proposed for Wood Way. However, the application was deferred pending the Parish Council carrying out a survey of residents in an area defined by the NEPP being those properties that will be most effected by such measures. The area marked on the plan by the NEPP comprises numbers 2-42 Cuckoo Way and numbers 7,10,12 and 14 Wood Way being 25 houses in all. The requirement set out by the NEPP was that 75% of the households in that area must support the proposed interventions.

The Parish Council therefore set up a survey with SurveyMonkey and sent an explanatory letter to those residents which included a link to the survey with a request that the survey be completed by 16th January 2023.


At the close of the survey 12 out of 25 houses had completed the survey and the results can be seen below
